Just to keep you informed,

Following two successful stage two appeal hearings for school transport that I won on behalf of local students the school transport committee have reversed the decision to axe sixteen concessionary routes in Cornwall that would have come in to effect this Autumn term and have started a consultation with those students and parents that are at present receiving free transport on these routes.

A number of local members myself included believe that officers have acted outside of the delegated powers they have, Also the routes where assessed as unfit which is why the students where in receipt of the free transport.

Overnight the routes where reclassified as fit for purpose something we all dispute. There will be a review following the consultation.

With regards the request by a member of the public to stop vehicles parking in front of the benches at the bottom of Nancherow Hill on the Tregaseal junction having spoken with the Highway Manager we have asked the TRI SERVICE OFFICER to place warning notices on the offending vehicles and monitor the situation the notices will inform them it is an offence to park within 10 mts of a junction if this fails to deter them we will have to step up the action.

No doubt you will have heard on the news the issue regarding RACC concrete having been used in schools across the country, I have been informed today that no schools that fall under Council responsibility are affected and that the Academy providers are making arrangements with the relevant bodies to seek guidance.
