I have been notified of a parcel of 1.5 acres of agricultural land at Drift that the Council are considering offloading as it is surplus to requirements and this Council has considered expressing an interest in acquiring it for community use I would be more than happy to assist in any way I can to support your ambitions once you as a Council have had the opportunity to discuss how you wish to proceed.

There is much going on at the moment around the Draft budget and the many cuts to services proposed to maintain a balanced budget going forward I will as always do my utmost to represent the views of those I represent but unless money is forthcoming from central government it will be impossible to stop all the cuts planned and not reach the situation where the Council would have to issue a section 114 notice such as other less prudent authorities have had to do.
