

Good evening I will keep it brief this month to allow members to ask questions, The main topics at the moment seem to be the works on the A3071 and the impacts that this is having, the street light switch off and the issues of some lights being left on and others that residents would like on but the request has been refused, also the rollout of the new waste arrangements have caused some concerns that may well have been addressed in the rollout so far. With regards the A3071 I have requested an update and the latest design map from the officer in charge which will hopefully answer some of the questions that have been raised. The street lighting switch off has been rolling out across the County in consultation with the Police and consideration has to given to the Highways law for the UK and some lights will remain on at night for this reason, of course any member of the public can request different considerations for specific lights but these will have to considered carefully. The waste management rollout has gone well so far and the process will continue it is beneficial that we were not the first as many little issues have been highlighted and measures taken to ease the process going forward, but that said there are still some significant obstacles that have been raised with me by local residents and I would like to thank them for their thought's and the suggestions on how to make the rollout more usable in particular locations, as a result of the input I have received at the CAP meeting in April we will have a joint meeting with the neighbouring CAP regarding the rollout at the start of the meeting on a separate link and then after questions we will revert to the normal CAP agenda separately for each CAP on another link something both Guy and I thought would be beneficial as the rollout next phase will cover both CAP areas and it will save officers time and give more time for engagement with members.

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
